The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

The class of this ship is subject to soft nose stem and structure in way being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking.

SPECIAL SURVEY (C) becomes due 9,59.

The ship was last examined in dry dock 7,58.

The LONDON Surveyors report, the ship examined afloat for the purpose of issuing a certificate allowing it to be towed as a hulk to Rotterdam. The condition of the ship considered satisfactory for the proposed voyage.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the proposal to tow the ship as a hulk to Rotterdam merits approval, but ~~further~~ ACTION be DEFERRED pending further information, subject as above.
