Nature of Survey S.S. for Classification, When due Alterations and Repairs.

This tanker was built in 1944 and classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

Classification with this Society is desired.

Plans for this type of vessel have been examined in this Office and the scantlings and arrangements found suitable for the class 100A- "Carrying Petroleum in bulk".

The NEW YORK Surveyors in a First Entry Report and Rpt 8, report 3.48 the vessel placed in dry dock, the scantlings and arrangements verified, the requirements for Vessels Not Built Under Survey and of a Periodical Special Survey complied with.

The deck and bottom shell has been cut and strapped at this time.

The equipment of anchors and chain cables on board is equivalent to Rule requirements and has been tested by the American Bureau of Shipping.
