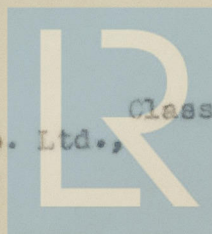

I duly received your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the steamers "IONIA" and "CORINTHIA", and have to confirm the intimation given you on the telephone to-day that the vessels' classes in the Register Book will remain undisturbed during such time as they are under the aegis of the Naval Authorities for maintenance.
