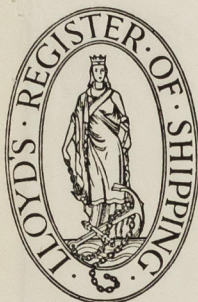

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Rye-Arc Ltd., attend at their works at Silvertown, North Woolwich Road, London, E.16 on the 7th February, 1958, and subsequent dates, for the purpose of examining One "Fort" and "Liberty" type rudder.

The Rudder has been made in accordance with the approved plan, Drawing No. B5197/2, examined during the course of construction and the materials throughout are satisfactory.

The rudder mainpiece is made of Siemens Martin tested ingot steel (see Sunderland Forging Certificate No. 8969).

The rudder is made of Lloyd's Tested steel plates, using approved welding Electrodes.
