I have to acknowledge receipt of your memorandum of the 20th February, the contents of which have been noted.

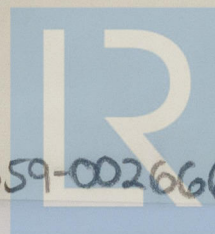
The case has received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today and it has been decided to record a notation of "Surveys overdue 3.60" in the Society's Register Book.
