Enclosed herewith we beg to forward free translation of a letter received from the Owners of the above Vessel, which is self-explanatory.

We only have to add that all the items of Special Survey, excepting Docking, have now been completed including repairs to rudder pintles, which were carried out by taking the rudder ashore, and refitting same on board with Vessel afloat.

The difficulty of obtaining a dry dock now in the stated districts really exists, and in our opinion the request of the Owners to defer for a few months the docking, merits favourable consideration by the Committee.

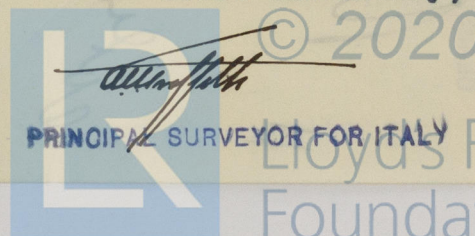
The Registro Italiano has also agreed to the above request and the ship is expected to sail today. Pending your answer no certificate has been issued.
