With reference to your letter of the 1st instant, regarding the settling tank fittings, on the above vessel, I beg to inform you that the plan N°1258 which was forwarded with our letter of the 23rd ult. was incorrect, with regard to the suction valves of the settling tanks, as these were so geared that they could be shut off from the boat deck, and the drain cocks were of self closing type in accordance with Section 49 of the Rules.

With regard to the gauge glass fittings of the settling tanks, the builders have been informed of the Committee's requirements and they state that the necessary alterations will be carried out at the earliest opportunity.

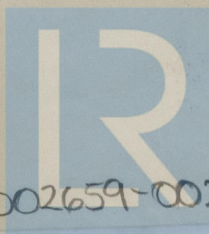
