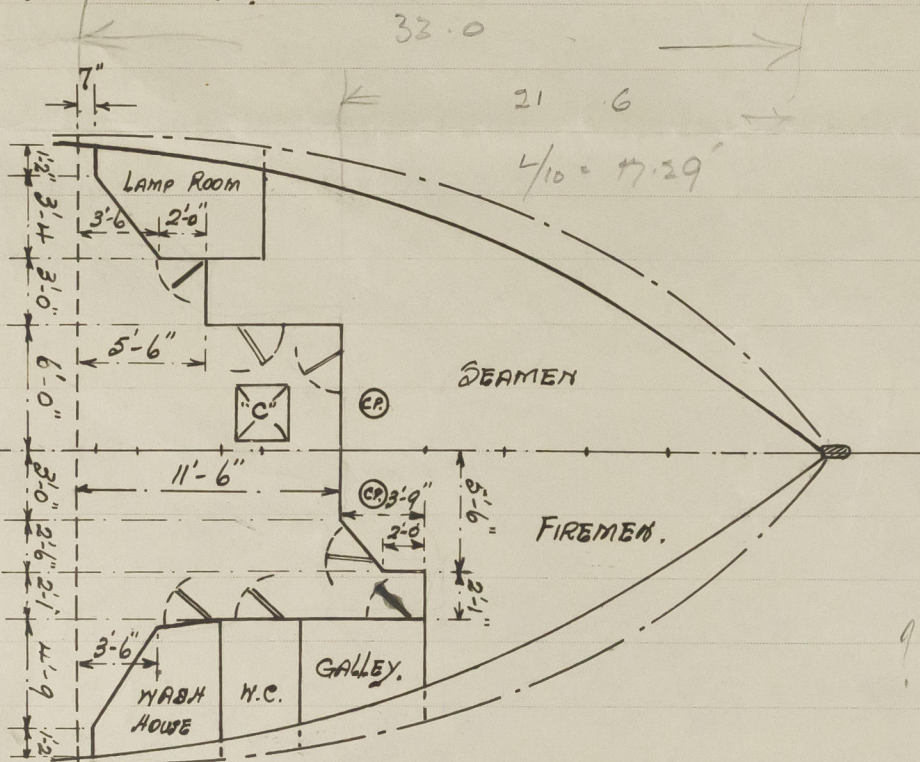

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in Belfast, January 1940.

Alteration of crew accommodation from Lower Forecastle space to existing Open Forecastle.

The existing companionway in open B'castle now dispensed with and opening in upper deck permanently closed with steel plate elec-welded. Steel Bulkhead now erected across existing Open B'castle (see above sketch), coaming & plating 22"; Stiffeners 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 x .25; spaced 30" apart; size of openings 7 @ 5'-0" x 24"; Height of sills 9"; Height of casing 7'-0".

Solid 1 1/2" wood doors capable of being operated from both sides fitted. Forecastle space fitted with hinged deadlights and 2 additional 7 1/2 x 3 1/2" oval Dyffle type Ventilators fitted to the Forecastle deck leading to New Crew Space below, Coaming 2'-9" x 1/4" thick.

A Small Hatchway, marked "C", has been fitted to the upper deck, aft of the New Forecastle front bulkhead, leading to the existing crew space now converted to Store space and the New Chain locker strongly built of wood has been erected in this space.

Size of Hatchway 2'-4" x 2'-4" x 24" Coaming plate, with sufficient hatch cleats, battens, 2 1/2" res angles, 2 1/2" wood cover and 2 tarpaulins.
