
The Rotterdam Surveyors have stated that the Owners representative informed them that the ship would sail to Savona in ballast, and on arrival the ship would be laid up and possibly be sold for scrap.

Furthermore the Surveyors state that the general condition of the ship is such that in their opinion no postponement of the Special Survey can be recommended. Please bear this in mind should any question of postponement of the Special Survey arise.
