Our No. 1465 Ship - Freeboard.

In the case of the single screw tank steamship, our No. 1465, which we are building for American owners (Pan American Petroleum & Transport Co. of New York) to your Society's class, the ship is to receive American Registry on completion and prior to departure from this country. The question, therefore, arises as to which Authority will then assign the freeboard, and we shall be pleased to know whether this will be undertaken by your Society on behalf of the American Authorities. It is the owners' intention eventually to have the freeboard in accordance with the new Load Line Convention rules for tankers.
