I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant respecting the refrigerating installation for Messrs. A/B Gotaverken's Yard No. 476, and shall be glad if you will state the ice melting capacity in accordance with the evaporator and condenser temperatures, as laid down on page 159 of the Rules.

I may point out that in the case of the largest insulated vessel recorded in Vol. 17 of the Register Book the ice melting capacity does not approach the figure of 2160 tons given in your letter.
