I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant enclosing your Report No.4112 on the refrigerating installation constructed by Messrs. A/S Drammens Jernstoberi & Mek.Verkstet for Messrs. A/B Gotaverken's Yard No.476, and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the ice melting capacity should be calculated on the basis of the evaporator and condenser temperatures, as laid down on page 159 of the Society's Rules. You should, therefore, state the total ice melting capacity of the four compressors under these conditions.

It is concluded that the number of strokes is 750 per minute, and not 375 as stated in the report, but I shall be glad to learn if this is so.

It is noted that the survey will be completed at Gothenburg, and the Society's Surveyors at that port are being advised accordingly.
