The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

The class of this ship is *100A1.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) becomes due 6,60 and she was last examined in dry dock in 6,57.

The ship was reported laid up at Helsingfors in 1,59.

Request for issue of certificate to allow the ship to proceed as a hulk in tow from Helsingfors to Hamburg approved 0.4.59, subject to a satisfactory examination.

The HELSINGFORS Surveyors report (4,59), the ship examined afloat and the condition considered satisfactory for proposed voyage.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the proposal to tow the ship as a hulk to Hamburg merits approval, but further ACTION be DEFERRED pending further information.
