With reference to the First Entry Reports N^o 1306 on L. Rates forwarded herewith I have the honor to report that the Kedge Anchor N^o 20865 placed onboard is rather under full weight viz 5^{Cent} -- 22 lbs instead of 5¹/₄ Cent as required per Rule. —

Under Circumstances that considerable trouble & delay had been experienced in getting all these Anchors at all from the U.K. — and as they only arrived and were placed onboard on 30th January 1900 — and hence no time to refuse it — I have thought that I could respectfully recommend the Class & figure 1 be granted — seeing that weight is only 6 lbs short. —
