the vessel, following was found and recommendations were made  
without prejudice to the terms and conditions of the insurance.

FOUND

One bower anchor and six lengths of 15 fathoms each stud link  
chain cable missing;

RECOMMENDED


One bower anchor and six lengths of 15 fathoms each stud link  
chain cable of proper size and weight to be supplied.

HOW DONE:

One bower anchor and six length of 15 fathoms each stud link  
chain cable supplied and fitted.

On this occasion also one bower anchor and three lengths  
of 15 fathoms each of stud link chain cable have been supplied  
and fitted on board so as to make up for the loss which occurred  
on the 14th-15th December 1957 (See Split Damage Report No.2033  
dated the 16th December 1957).
