On 1.2.60 the Owners' proposal to hold the next Drydocking Survey in June, 1962 (4 years after last drydocking) was approved, provided copies of the Canadian Government Inspector's reports were sent to this Office. In this letter it was presumed that postponement of the Screwshaft Survey would also be required until 6.62 and the Owners were informed that such a proposal would be approved if arrangements were made for the wear down of the stern bush to be taken about 2 years after each Screwshaft Survey (last Screwshaft Survey held 6.58).

The Vancouver Surveyors now submit a report by the Canadian Department of Transport, covering an examination held in Tuk^{toot}uk Harbour on the 5th June. The Inspector states, however, that it is impossible to take the wear down of the screwshaft while the ship is afloat and as the ship operates in clear water for a period of 6 weeks in a year, it is thought that perhaps the shafting could be accepted for the full period (until 6.62). See endorsement on Montreal letter dated 4.7.60.
