We enclose herewith a letter dated 27th instant from Mr. J. Moorcroft, Canadian Steamship Inspector, reporting on the above vessel which he examined in Tuktoyaktuk Harbour on the 5th June, 1960.

With reference to the London letters dated 1st February last dealing with this vessel's surveys, we have to advise you that Mr. Moorcroft has stated that it is impossible to take the wear down of the screwshaft whilst the vessel is afloat. As the ship operates in clear water for a period of six weeks in the year, it is thought perhaps the shafting could be accepted for the full period.
