

## PROVISIONAL CLASSIFICATION CERTIFICATE

**This is to Certify that**

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners, Messrs. Hudson's Bay Company, Ltd., Winnipeg, survey the hull and machinery of the Wood Motor Vessel "FORT HEARNE" of Montreal, Official Number 190466, during construction at Messrs. John Etherington Limited, Shelburne, N. S., and that I have satisfied myself that the vessel has been built in accordance with the approved plans and the Rule requirements, or their equivalent, and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, united with the British Corporation Register, Glasgow, Scotland, a report stating that I consider the vessel to be seaworthy, and recommending that the vessel be classed BS<sup>#</sup> and the machinery M.B.S.<sup>#</sup> with this Society and entered in the Register Book as "Class Contemplated" pending consideration of our report by the Committee and the issuing of Classification Certificates.
