With reference to the classing letter of the 9th instant and to Belfast Report 10,359 on the above vessel, I beg to state that the capacity of the tanks between the tunnel and the ship's side is as follows -

- Forward tank (33 to 44 frames) 176 tons oil, port and starboard combined.
- After tank (21 to 32 frames) 113 tons Fresh water, port and starboard combined.

The oil has been taken at 38½ and the Fresh water at 36 cubic feet to the ton.
