With reference to your 'M' letter of the 1st instant giving particulars of the freeboard assigned to the above vessel, I beg to state that four freeing ports 48" x 12" are fitted each side in the well forward of the bridge and four of the same size each side in the well aft of the bridge. The ends of these wash ports are rounded and a centre horizontal rail is fitted.
