Escape Hatch: An escape hatch strongly built of steel fitted on port side
shelter deck aft for escape from gunners quarters in No. 5 shelter 'tween decks
opening 22" x 24" x 18" high, between deck beams 13 & 14 and close by strong
hinged steel cover, capable of being operated from both sides.
