The undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Power Flexible Tubing Co. Ltd., attend their Works at Vale Road, Pinsbury Park, N.4., on the 24th May, 1950, for the purpose of inspecting One 30'-0" length $\frac{5}{8}$ " bore galvanised steel flexible tubing, made to Order No. 19007 of Messrs Cammell Laird & Co. Ltd., and intended for the s.s. "PROSPECTOR".

Fitted at each end of the galvanised steel hose are gunmetal couplings with flat faced neck pieces and lock nuts, screwed $1\frac{1}{4}$ " female B.S.P. threads.

The pipe is intended for a working pressure of 100 lbs. per square inch saturated steam and was subjected to hydraulic test pressure of 200 lbs. per square inch, at which pressure was found to be sound and tight.

For identification purposes the coupling nut was stamped:-


