Motorship "CARLSHAMN"

The following is the text of a cablegram dated the 16th instant which has been received from the Surveyors at Stockholm:-

"CARLSHAMN RE YOUR LET 16th DECEMBER TO GOTHENBURG  
STOP OWNERS WILL ASK ROTTERDAM SURVEYORS HOLD  
SURVEY FOR ISSUE OF CERTIFICATE FOR VESSEL TO BE  
TOWED FROM MIDDELBURG TO BRUEGGE STOP PLEASE  
INSTRUCT ROTTERDAM"

It will be in order for you to issue the desired certificate provided the tanker is surveyed in accordance with requirements of Circular No. 1959 and found or placed in a satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage in ballast. The question of drydocking is left to your discretion and, in this respect, I would refer you to your report No. 47730.

Any certificate issued should indicate:-

1. That the ship is unclassified during the voyage.
2. It relates only to the fitness of the hull to be towed.
3. The towage arrangements are the responsibility of the Owners.
