The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 11.57. (Tanker 21 years old).

A proposal to carry out a G.E. afloat about 10th November for postponement of the S.S. until April '58 was approved 25.10.57.

A proposal to hold the S.S. in February '58 was also approved 10.1.58.

The Nap. Surveyors report (8.58) S.S. of this ship commenced by the examination afloat of cargo tanks, No.1 hold, Fore peak tanks and fore peak spaces, and repairs recommended to Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 cargo tanks, also to the upper deck in way of the forecastle.

The drilling of the shell, deck and bulkheads commenced so far as possible with the ship afloat, but the results obtained have been retained for completion of the S.S.

It is noted from Nap. memo dated 2.3.59 that the ship is LAID UP and the Survey is, meanwhile, suspended.

The Year of Grace expired 11,58.

In view of the above, the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
