Messrs. Sandilands Buttery & Co. Ltd., Lloyd's Agents and The Malay States Shipping Co. Ltd., Ships Agents, Penang attend on board the S.S. "GOLDEN BETA" 5389 tons gross of HONG KONG on 1st November, 1958 and subsequent date, whilst vessel lay afloat in Penang Harbour, for the purpose of examining hull damage.

It was stated that while vessel was at Tanjong Dawai north of Penang loading iron ore the vessel's crew were chipping Starboard G Strake plate in way of frame 83 from aft the plate was holed on 1st November 1958 at 10.30 a.m. Vessel fitted cement box and returned to Penang for survey of damage and repairs.

Now Done. On Sunday 2nd November 1958 a 3/8" thick mild steel doubler 2'6" wide by 4 feet high was fitted with hole which was immediately abaft frame No.83 at centre and welded all round. The doubler was hose tested and found sound and tight.

It is recommended that the vessel remains as now classed and that a permanent repair be effected at next dry-docking.
