Dear Sirs,

Replying to your letter of the 16th instant respecting the "STAVROS", I have to acquaint you that as requested by you, the necessary instructions regarding the survey of this ship were cabled to the Society's Surveyors at Piræus on the 15th instant, and on the 17th instant full instructions regarding the opening on the tonnage opening were airmailed to the Surveyors.

Replying to the enquiry contained in the last paragraph of your letter, I have to say that as an open shelter decker the summer extreme draught will be approximately 24'-10", and the deadweight approximately 570 tons less than at present, but the actual deadweight is not known.
