Dear Mr. Chisholm,

I am favoured with your letter of the 5th instant, from which I am pleased to learn that the sum of R.M. 11,110 has now been paid into the Hamburg account by Messrs. Fried. Krupp, Kiel, in connexion with the outstanding accounts against this Firm, which were detailed in the copy of Messrs. Krupp's letter, dated 25th ultimo, which accompanied yours of the 30th ultimo.

I note that Messrs. Krupp's advice to you stated that their remittance was made as part payment of the total of R.M. 21,845, and I am pleased to say that we have today received here a sterling cheque from Messrs. Krupp for the balance of E.M. 10,735, which now satisfactorily clears up the whole matter.

In these circumstances you will of course be in order in handing over the classification certificates for the Tanker "W. B. WALKER", and I am forwarding the machinery certificate for the Tanker "G. S. WALDEN" to the Rotterdam Surveyors, intimating that this may now be handed over to the Builders, together with the hull certificate of this vessel, it being understood from your letter of the 18th ultimo that the Engineers would have no objection to the
