Dear Mr. Scott,

Reverting to my letter of the 30th ultimo regarding the Hamburg fees for the tankers "G.S.WALDEN" and "W.B.WALKER", and also the previous correspondence which has taken place regarding the fees for these two vessels, I have to advise you that the sum of RM.11.110.-- has been paid today into the Hamburg account by Messrs. Fried. Krupp, Kiel. From the copy of Messrs. Krupp's letter, dated 25.9.35, which was forwarded with mine of the 30th ultimo, it will be seen that the payment now made covers all the accounts contained in Messrs. Krupp's letter above referred to, but a balance of RM.10735.-- is still outstanding which may be regarded as applicable to the account, dated 1.7.35, for the "W.B.WALKER". In the circumstances as Messrs. Krupp's advice to us states that the payment now made is a part payment of the total amount of RM.21845.-- arrangements could, if considered, be made to supply the Owners with classification certificates applicable to the "G.S.WALDEN" and the corresponding records could be arranged for in the Register Book. It is presumed that no action should be taken by us in regard to the certificates for the "W.B.WALKER" until the balance which is still owing is received from Messrs. Krupp.


