Dear Mr. Chisholm,

My attention has been drawn to the non-payment of the Hamburg fees in the cases of the new tankers "G.S. WALDEN" and "W.B. WALKER".

In the former case, the Shipbuilders at Rotterdam have paid their fees, and until the machinery fees of Rm.2200 are paid, the classification certificates cannot be issued, or records of classification be posted in the Register Book.

With regard to the "W.B.WALKER", I see that the Hamburg account was rendered to Messrs. Krupp on the 1st July last for Rm. 18950. This sum represents the services of the Society's Surveyors over a considerable period, and it is reasonable to expect payment of such a large amount with as little delay as possible.

Another aspect of the matter is that the payment of these two accounts would in all probability render it unnecessary for you to call on us for funds for at least two months. I shall be glad, therefore, if you will make suitable representations to Messrs. Krupp with a view to expediting payment, and let me know the result.
