Parts now examined:—

Sea connection inlets and discharges.

All main engine cylinders, liners, valves and valve gears, transverse beam bearings and pins, upper and lower pistons and rods. Nos. 2 and 4 main engine side rods, centre and side crossheads and bearings, connecting rods, centre and side crank pins and bearings. Nos. 1 and 3 Main engine centre crossheads and bearings. All (Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5) Main engine crankshaft journals and bearings. Thrust block shaft and bearings. Main engine attached lubricating oil pump, fresh water cooling pump and sea water circulating pump. Port and Starboard air compressors with their engines and intercoolers. Steam dynamo (30 Kw) engine and diesel dynamo (30 KW.) engine. Auxiliary condenser. Bilge pump, ballast pump and G.S. pump. Lubricating oil cooler and fresh water cooler. Windlass engine. Port and Starboard donkey boilers. Alterations to enable heavy oil fuel to be used in the main engine.
