The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—*Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.*)

The class is subject to indented poop side shell plating etc. (s.s) being dealt with before the ship is recommissioned.

The Owners through the Piraeus Surveyors requested a certificate for a voyage in tow from Piraeus to an Italian port, with a possible view to scrapping.

The Surveyors were accordingly advised that the Owners request would be agreed to provided the ship was found suitable for the contemplated voyage and that the class would be temporarily suspended.

The Piraeus Surveyors report (10,61) the ship examined afloat and found or placed in satisfactory condition for the towage voyage to an Italian port as an unclassified ship.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED pending further information regarding the disposal of this ship, subject as above.
