The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

The class is subject to after keel plates (corroded) being examined at the next drydocking, and to wasted shell plate B.9 (p.s. from fwd) being examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 11.58. Postponement until 10.59 approved 8.12.58. The year of grace expired 10.59.

See also correspondence dated 30.10.59, 13.11.59 and 19.11.59 regarding request for a Modified S.S. Notation being assigned.

The RIO DE JANEIRO Surveyors report (11.59), ship examined and repaired in dry dock and her condition considered satisfactory for the proposed notation with restriction of service.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the ship's class be amended to 100A1 ^{between} "For Coasting Service ~~in~~ Santos and Fortaleza" with record of 'DS 11.59' and Notation of 'SS(M) 11.59(12 mos.)' assigned, subject as above.
