Dear Sir,

I beg to return herewith the classification certificate for the Steamer "INVERTYDE" built by Messrs. Henry Scarr Ltd., of Hesse, for correction. The section as shown on the certificate is in accordance with the original approved Midship Section, but approved plans of modifications to steelwork showing the arrangements for converting the vessels into fuel oil carriers were forwarded with the first entry report, and these are the plans of the vessel as she now is and it will be noted that on these plans a centre line non O.T. bulkhead and side stringers are shown but no ceiling is fitted.
