I have to acquaint you that the General Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day the cases of the steamers "BETTERTON", "KEWANEE" and "TULSAGAS" (New York reports Nos. 27473, 27474 and 27475), and to say that in view of the intimation received from the Owners that they wish to withdraw these vessels from the Society's classification, the decision of the American Committee of the 13th ultimo to withdraw the character of each steamer from the Register Book and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof, has been confirmed.
