A small hatchway 19" x 30" with 7" steel coaming and steel watertight cover now  
fitted on forecastle deck.

A substantial steel companionway now fitted on after end of bridge deck to new  
gunners' accommodation, companionway fitted with substantial wood door 48" x 27"  
with 18" sill.

One 9" portlight fitted in bridge side plating (starboard side) and one 18" portlight  
in after bulkhead of bridge, both portlights fitted with deadlights.
