on JUNE 1954 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~:—

(1) 1 New 8" diameter Cowl Vent fitted on Forecastle Deck and trunked through Forecastle space to Forward Ballast Pump Room, coaming 36" high x 36" thick, wood plug and canvas cover supplied.

(2) 1 New 6" diameter Cowl Vent to pipe tunnel, fitted through poop front bulkhead and led to above line of poop deck, Coaming 36" thick supported to poop front bulkhead. Wood plug and canvas cover supplied.

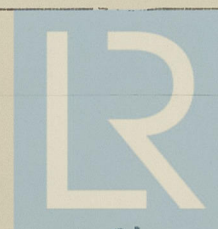
