Dear Sirs,

With reference to the letter dated the 14th November last addressed to you by the Society's Head Office in London regarding the s.s. "FINVOY", I now have to inform you that the Committee have today had before them a report received from the Aberdeen Surveyors of their examination of this ship in drydock.

The bottom and rudder have been cleaned, examined and re-coated, and some wear and tear repairs carried out.

Parts of the machinery were also examined at this time with satisfactory results, and in view of the reports now received the Committee will be agreeable to the Special Survey, which became due at the end of last month, being postponed until January, 1959.

The Boiler Survey has also been completed on this occasion, and in the meantime the Committee have assigned a docking date of 1,58 Buckie, with records of General Examination, G.E. 1,58, MBS 1,58.

As you are aware the class of the ship is subject to spare steering gear buffer spring being supplied at the earliest opportunity.
