Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant respecting the Steamer "FRITHA", and in confirmation of my letter of the 24th December, I have to say that particulars of the freeboards and the conditions of assignment have been cabled to the Society's Surveyor at Karachi, and he has been instructed to issue a Provisional Load Line Certificate valid for six months, when the freeboards have been marked and verified, the conditions complied with, and the Classification Survey completed.

This is in accordance with the usual practice and there is no reason to suppose that this Provisional Certificate will not be accepted.

The Official Certificate and certified copy will be issued when the final reports are received from the Surveyor.

As explained over the telephone, the Classification Certificates will be issued when the final reports are received from the Society's Surveyor at Karachi and he is being requested by airmail to forward his reports without delay.
