Dear Mr. Leathard,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant with enclosures relating to the freeboard assignment for Osbourne Graham's No. 244, "S.N.A.6".

In the circumstances I have prepared a fresh report giving the freeboard as for the British assignment, 2'-3½", measured from the statutory line 1¾" above the steel deck at side, and I enclose two memos giving the corresponding freeboard 1¾" less, as measured from the statutory deck line marked at the intersection of the steel deck at side, as required by the French regulations. Please hand one of these to the Builders, and retain the other for yourself, returning to me in due course the memo first sent.

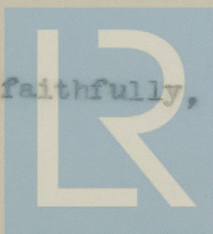
I trust this will put the matter quite satisfactory for the Builders.
