Ltd., attend their works at North Circular Road, N.W. 10., on the 6th March, 1950, for the purpose of inspecting the following soot blowing equipment, made to Order No. R.17535 (21.1.50) of Messrs Cammell Laird & Co. Ltd., Birkenhead and intended for installation in Three single end, Scotch type, three furnaced boilers, working pressure 220 lbs. per square inch of the s.s. "DOTTEREL".

Each of the three sets comprise the following:-

Three 15" M.M.49. soot blowers, chain drive control.

Three 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " bore distance pieces.

One 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Master Valve, straight through type, in gun-metal.

One 3/8" gun-metal drain valve.

totalling nine soot blowers, three master valves and three drain valves.

The blower steam chests of cast steel construction and master steam valves were hydraulically tested to 600 lbs. per square inch with satisfactory results and for identification each flange was stamped:-

Examination of the different component parts revealed them to be of good workmanship.
