I duly received your letter of the 20th February concerning the above "G" class vessels which, it is noted, are required to undertake occasional voyages to Christmas Island.

This latest proposal has been investigated both from the classification and freeboard points of view, and I am pleased to inform you that the ships have been found suitable for the extended service to Christmas Island at the present draught of 20'5½". The Committee have accordingly agreed to this extension of service, and each case will be submitted to them shortly with a view to an amendment of class.

The Load Line Certificates will, of course, require to be endorsed to include this extension, and it is suggested the most convenient time for this to be done would be when each ship next calls at Singapore. If you will kindly confirm that this will suit your arrangements, the necessary instructions will be sent to the Society's Surveyors at that port.
