"G" Class Vessels

I enclose for your information a copy of a letter dated the 19th instant which has been received from Shell Tankers Limited, together with one of my reply today from which you will observe that the class of the above ships is being amended to include occasional voyages to Hong Kong at the freeboards now permitted for service in the Indonesian Archipelago.

This, of course, means that there will be no necessity for the freeboards to be altered and a short term Load Line Certificate issued for each voyage to Hong Kong as stated in my letter of the 15th August last.

The service limits appearing on the Load Line Certificates of the ships already trading in the Indonesian Archipelago will require amendment and when so requested by the Owners' local Representatives, you may in each case add the words "and occasional voyages to Hong Kong" after satisfying yourselves with the general condition of the freeboard items. You should, of course, report when this has been done.
