Thank you for your letter of the 22nd August about the "JAMES H. BEAZLEY", and the Surveyor has noted that the Class should be subject to the welded tubes in the centre nest of the boiler being dealt with by the end of 10,57.

On this point I am asked to call your attention to the case of the "CLAN CAMERON" in which the tubes were welded some years ago, and no subject has ever been recorded against the ship.

Several of the Surveyors believe that there are similar cases although they cannot recall the names at the moment.

With this in mind, and understanding that the Owners would in any case deal with the matter in October, as stated in the Report, you will appreciate why the Surveyor did not make the matter a Condition of Class.
