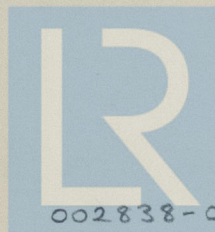
For the CHIEF SHIP SURVEYOR and CHIEF ENGINEER SURVEYOR.

The class should be made subject to the six welded tubes in the centre rest of the boiler being dealt with before the end of 10.57. The Liverpool Surveyors advised that outstanding defects affecting classification should always be made the subject of a condition of class, irrespective of any arrangements which have been made for them to be dealt with.
