Your letter will be relayed to our Principals but as a matter of form in this case because we have already been made aware of the Owners' decision to the effect that completion of discharge of the cargo with which the ship is scheduled to arrive London on the 29th April next, will terminate the vessel's service with present Owners, the intention being then to scrap the ship.
