We acknowledged receipt of your letter dated 30th ultimo with thanks. In reply, we wish you will agree to survey the boilers after her arrival at Tokuyama, Japan by early June.

Due to alteration of trade as previously arranged for her arrival at Japan by middle of March instead, we are awfully sorry that the vessel just completed loading of salt today. We shall indeed inform you in due time for the invitation of survey.

For your reference, the ship has six boilers and we are now using three only as to save consumption in spite of slower speed. Three boilers have been surveyed in December last year at Ishikawajima during passing her annual docking.
