Dear Sirs,

I am favoured with your letter of the 1st instant respecting the proposal to fit superheaters to the s.s. "FORDSDALE", and in reply, I have to say that the proposal to fit cast steel triple valve chests in place of the existing main stop valves on the boilers is considered satisfactory, provided suitable arrangements be made for the expansion and draining of the steam pipes, the scantlings of the chests be suitable for the proposed working pressure and the steel castings be made at approved works and be tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

It is noted that the temperature of the steam at the outlet from the superheater will be 625°F.

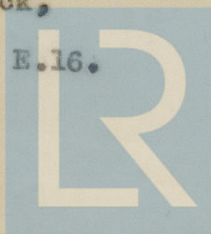
