Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in

Alterations and additions effected at Birkenhead - Nov. 1952.

existing crew's accommodation in Poop space extended with access from companionway on P. side - Companionway constructed of steel adequately stiffened having opening 4'9" x 2'-1" closed by strong wood door operated both sides. Height of sill at opening 8" above deck. A total of 10 additional 9" dia. side scuttles fitted - all with hinged deadlights of approved type.

2 - 2½" dia scuppers fitted discharging overboard below main deck and fitted with storm valves.

New accommodation fitted at after end of Bridge superstructure space - S. side - with access from inside existing house on Bridge deck. Opening 5'-0" x 2'-1" - sill 18" above deck - and closed by strong wood door operated both sides.

A total of 7-12" dia. side scuttles fitted - all with hinged deadlights of approved pattern.

3 - 2½" scuppers (2 P. + 1 D.) from existing amidships accommodation in Bridge deck - discharging overboard below main deck and fitted with storm valves.

2 - 2" scuppers from new accommodation in Bridge space discharging overboard below main deck - fitted with storm valves.

1-4" and 1-2½" scuppers from new accommodation (Hospital) in Bridge space discharging overboard below main deck fitted with ground storm valves.
