I am in receipt of your Report No.4448 and with regard thereto I have to inform you that in view of the ship's age and her condition as now found by you, the case must be reported to the Committee without delay, and for their information I shall be glad if you will ascertain and cable this Office the Owners' definite intentions with regard to the Special Survey and the completion of all necessary repairs. You should also state whether, in your opinion, the ship is in a satisfactory condition to lay up indefinitely.

I have to add that in view of the condition of the ship as now reported by you, it is considered that the Special Survey should include full drilling as for a 'D' Survey.
