Coasters owned in South Africa and trading within its borders are now obliged to carry a loadline certificate issued by the Marine Division, Department of Transport of South Africa, should however the vessels trade outside the limits, the approved assigning authorities may issue certificates.

I have now been informed that the "Namaqua Coast", "Mashona Coast" and "Zulu Coast" do not trade beyond the South African borders and therefore, the Owners are obliged to apply to the Marine Division for loadline certificates, and I am pleased to report that otherwise they will continue to class the vessels with the Society.

Please find enclosed a letter from the Principal Officer, Marine Division requesting copies of the computations and conditions of assignment which will help them considerably in issuing the new certificates.
